Alternative Concurrent Enrollment Registration Guidelines for the 2021-2022 Year

Registration through Dual Enroll

- Students who have not applied to Kirkwood will need to go to: <u>www.kirkwood.edu/hscreditapply</u>.
- Students will need to check their email on information for how to access their knumber.
- Using their knumber, they will be able to set up a password at <u>www.kirkwood.edu/password</u>.
- Registrations can be completed using knumbers and passwords at <u>www.kirkwood.dualenroll.com</u>.

Note: Students that do not register through Dual Enroll will be billed as self-pay and will be responsible for the cost of the course and the textbook. Students must drop the original registration and submit a new request through Dual Enroll to be approved by the counselor before they will be registered.

Deadlines for Enrollment

- Students registered by the on-time and the late start registration deadlines should expect their books to be delivered to their high school by the first day of class.
- Alternative Concurrent registrations will not be accepted after this date and students will be encouraged to register for a late start class instead.

Placement Score Requirements for Fall of 2021

- Please note that because of COVID19 closures, Kirkwood Community College has adjusted how placement scores will factor into registration for the fall of 2021 and for spring of 2022.
 - Online classes will not require placement scores in reading/writing unless scores are required for other placement purposes.
 - Scores will still be required for placement in math courses. The ALEKS placement test will be accessible online.
 - English courses, including Composition will require a high school GPA, OR Placement scores for placement purposes.
